

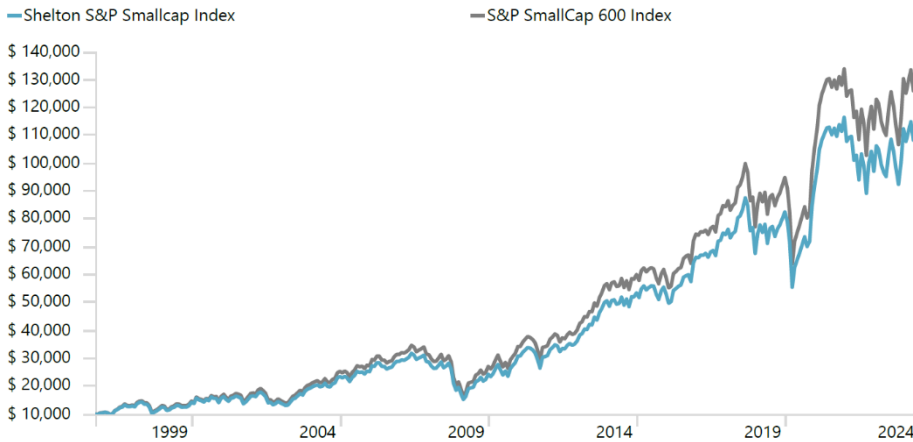
### Fund Objective
