

Fund Objective

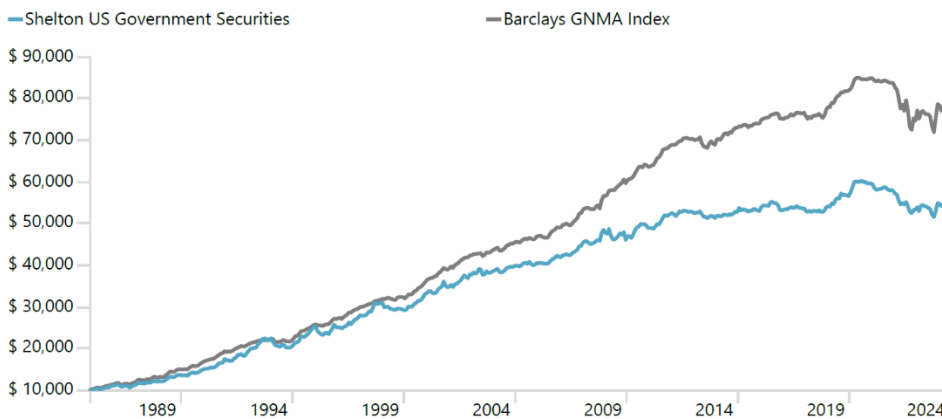
The Fund's investment objective is to seek liquidity, safety from credit risk and as high a level of income as is consistent with these objectives.

Shelton has contractually agreed to reimburse expenses incurred by the Fund to the extent that total annual fund operating expenses (excluding acquired fund fees and expenses, certain compliance costs, interest and broker expenses relating to investment strategies (including commissions, mark-ups and mark-downs), leverage interest, other transactional expenses, annual account fees for margin accounts, taxes (such as income and foreign withholding taxes, stamp duty and deferred tax expenses), extraordinary expenses such as litigation or merger and reorganization expenses, for example) exceed 0.75% and 1.25%. This agreement (the "Expense Agreement") shall continue until January 1, 2025.

- Target duration is usually three to twelve years

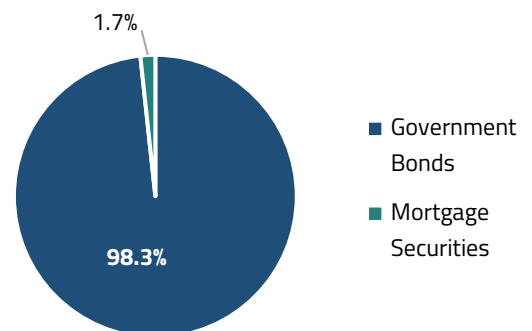
